## PROJECT OUTPUTS

We held the 40th Operational Coordination Meeting with the participation of the Directorate of Climate Change, European Union Delegation to Türkiye and Directorate General of European Union and Foreign Relations Authority on 16 August 2024.

We organised the second sectoral training focusing on water management, transportation and public health on 13-14 August in Eskişehir to raise awareness among local stakeholders. The training was attended by local stakeholders from public institutions, private sector and universities covered topics such as sectoral adaptation options and recommendations as well as good practices and sectoral risks.

We conducted a study visit to the Netherlands from 19-23 August 2024 to build capacity and discuss opportunities for cooperation. During the visit, the Ministry of Climate Policy and Green Growth, Climate Adaptation Services, Municipality of Amsterdam, Royal HaskoningDHV, Delta Climate Center, National Institute for Public Health and the Environment, Port of Rotterdam, RWS-Oosterscheldekering, Municipality of Middelburg, Ministry of Infrastructure and Water Management, Global Centre on Adaptation and Rotterdam Municipality were visited, and the delegates had the opportunity to observe how adaptation practices are integrated on the ground by examining different sectors.



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## GRANT PROGRAMME

We held an overview meeting with the Directorate of Climate Change and grant experts under the Climate Change Adaptation Grant Programme on 16 August 2024.

We held the first consultative meeting was organized on 28 August 2024 in İzmir. 29 grant projects and relevant stakeholders including universities, public institutions and civil society attended the meeting.

The second round of monitoring visits were conducted under the Grant Programme. Grant projects including İstanbul Chamber of Industry, İstanbul Regional Directorate of Forestry, Eastern Mediterranean Development Agency, TEMA Foundation, Polatlı Municipality and Eskişehir Governorate Provincial Directorate of Agriculture and Forestry were visited in August 2024.



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
