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PROJECT ACTIVITIES

To enhance local stakeholders' capacity for climate change adaptation, five trainings were organized in Ankara under the Climate Change Adaptation Strategy and Action Plan Implementation Guideline. The training strengthened stakeholders' capacity to implement climate change adaptation actions across key sectors.

- 30 June–1 July – The second session addressed the water resources and energy sectors, with 55 local stakeholders in attendance.
- 7–8 July – The third session focused on biodiversity, ecosystem services, and the agriculture sector, with 57 local stakeholders participating.



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- 16–17 July – The fourth session covered the health sector and disaster management, with 56 local stakeholders attending.

- 21–22 July – The fifth and final session examined urban adaptation, transportation, and communication sectors, with 56 local stakeholders in attendance.

Bringing together 100 stakeholders, the seventh awareness-raising conference took place on 31 July in Antalya under the theme “Climate Change and the Transportation and Communication Sector.” It promoted central and local climate change adaptation agendas and strengthened communication among participants.
