## PROJECT EVENTS

### Operation Coordination Unit Meeting

The 12th OCU meeting was held on 10 March 2021 where the information regarding the progress on the recruitment of TAT members, reporting and monitoring events and activities, and grant management were presented.

### Climate Change Vulnerability and Risk Analysis Scoping Meetings

Meetings were held in 12 separate online sessions and 1,651 stakeholder representatives from public institutions, the private sector, civil society, and academia gathered in different sector sessions. Following the speeches of sectoral experts, the participants shared the effects of climate change on their sectors. Following the main session on vulnerability and risk analysis methodology, climate change impact chain and indicators, the sector sessions on water resources, agriculture, tourism/ cultural heritage, social development, health, industry, urban, transportation/ communication, energy and ecosystem (land-cost) sector sessions were held for 6 days. In each sector session, sectoral vulnerability and risk analysis methodology was consulted within the framework of climate hazards, exposure, sensitivity, adaptation capacity factors.

Enhancing Climate Adaptation Action in Turkey Project has launched on 9 October 2019 with the collaboration between the Ministry of Environment and Urbanization (MoEU) and the United Nations Development Program Country Office Turkey (UNDP CO Turkey).

The overall objective of the project is set as “building societal resilience by strengthening climate change adaptation, particularly at sector and urban level” while the specific purpose is to establish an enabling environment for climate change adaptation in Turkey by developing the policy, technical and operational baselines, including

- better decision-making tools for national climate change adaptation policies,
- urban adaptation planning solutions (urban adaptation strategies and action plans)
- capacity building and networking activities for climate change adaptation with the EU and the international community, and
- a climate change adaptation grant programme to implement climate change adaptation action.

The project target groups are the relevant public institutions, local governments and municipalities, regional and provincial directorates, regional development agencies, chambers, unions, professional and business organizations, universities, research institutes, and civil society organizations. The target groups of the operation include all relevant non-state stakeholders and citizens.
