Climate Change Adaptation Prioritization Methodologies

A desk review of NASAP prioritization methodologies (i.e. cost-benefit, cost-effectiveness analysis, multi-criteria analysis, etc.) among EU member states, including good practices and lessons learned (including maladaptation practices) A stock-taking exercise on national strategies and policies for priority sectors, and international commitments and developments under multilateral environmental processes, such as the Paris Agreement, Sendai Framework, and SDGs was approved on May 15, 2021.

Climate Change Adaptation Strategy and Action Plans in Turkey and Some European Union Countries

A comparative analysis of the Turkish NASAP with selected EU member states, including (i) elaboration and update process, (ii) organizational and financial aspects, (iii) methodologies used for developing the strategy and prioritizing the actions, and (iv) recommendations for improvement in the context of Turkey with linkages to the SDGs. deskreview was approved on 6 May, 2021.

Enhancing Climate Adaptation Action in Turkey Project has launched on 9 October 2019 with the collaboration between the Ministry of Environment and Urbanization (MoEU) and the United Nations Development Program Country Office Turkey (UNDP CO Turkey).

The overall objective of the project is set as “building societal resilience by strengthening climate change adaptation, particularly at sector and urban level” while the specific purpose is to establish an enabling environment for climate change adaptation in Turkey by developing the policy, technical and operational baselines, including

- better decision-making tools for national climate change adaptation policies,
- urban adaptation planning solutions (urban adaptation strategies and action plans)
- capacity building and networking activities for climate change adaptation with the EU and the international community, and
- a climate change adaptation grant programme to implement climate change adaptation action.

The project target groups are the relevant public institutions, local governments and municipalities, regional and provincial directorates, regional development agencies, chambers, unions, professional and business organizations, universities, research institutes, and civil society organizations. The target groups of the operation include all relevant non-state stakeholders and citizens.
