## ACTIVITIES

The 25th Operation Coordination Meeting was on 1st June 2022, and the 26th Operation Coordination Meeting was held on 7 July 2022. At the meetings, the progress of the project and planned activities were shared with the Coordination Unit.

Local Climate Change Adaptation Strategy and Action Plan Consultative Meetings took place between 14-15 June 2022 in Samsun and 21-22 June 2022 inMuğla.

Within the scope of the studies regarding the update of the Samsun and Muğla Local Climate Change Adaptation Strategy and Action Plan, the consultative meetings were organized to determine the adaptation action options for urban, agriculture, livestock and fisheries, social development, energy, industry, transportation and communication, tourism and cultural heritage, public health, biodiversity, and ecosystem services and water resources management sectors. The stakeholder representatives 267 from Konya and 267 from Sakarya the public institutions, academia, non-governmental organizations, and private participated in the sessions, where climate change-induced risk management in the sectors, the urgency of climate adaptation actions, current practices and needs, and long-term action proposals were discussed. In addition, at the meeting, action proposals for the Samsun and Muğla Climate Change Adaptation Strategy and Action Plan were collected from the participants.

## **PROJECT OUTCOMES**

The revised version of the 2nd Progress Report was submitted on 22 June 2022.

A desk review to take stock of existing and expected future climate financing mechanisms at international and national level, to analyze climate financing strategies of selected EU member states with national adaptation strategies, and to evaluate existing finance mechanisms for other themes for best practices and lessons learned and A desk review to take stock of existing climate financing mechanisms at city level among EU member states, to analyze climate financing strategies of selected EU member states with UASAPs, and to evaluate existing finance mechanisms in Turkish cities for other themes for best practices and lessons learned revised version of reports were submitted on 27 July 2022.

Enhancing Climate Adaptation Action in Turkey Project has been launched on 9 October 2019 with the collaboration between the Ministry of Environment, Urbanization and Climate Change and the United Nations Development Programme in Turkey (UNDP Turkey).

The overall objective of the project is set as "building societal resilience by strengthening climate change adaptation, particularly at sector and urban level" while the specific purpose is to establish an enabling environment for climate change adaptation in Turkey by developing the policy, technical and operational baselines, including

- better decision-making tools for national climate change adaptation policies,
- urban adaptation planning solutions (urban adaptation strategies and action plans)
- capacity building and networking activities for climate change adaptation with the EU and the international community, and
- a climate change adaptation grant programme to implement climate change adaptation action.

The project target groups are the relevant public institutions, local governments and municipalities, regional and provincial directorates, regional development agencies, chambers, unions, professional and business organizations, universities, research institutes, and civil society organizations. The target groups of the operation include all relevant non-state stakeholders and citizens.
